

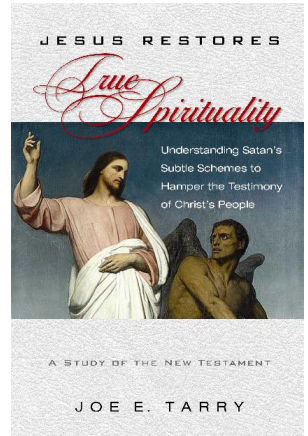

Seasoned Pastor Reveals Insights into How Jesus Defeats Satan's Attacks on God's People

GARLAND, TX – The term *spirituality* is a popular one, often in the minds of many. An Internet search reveals millions of results. Yet what does being spiritual really mean and how is spirituality achieved? In *Jesus Restores True Spirituality: Understanding Satan's Subtle Schemes to Hamper the Testimony of Christ's People*, veteran author Joe E. Tarry journeys through the New Testament to show how Satan attempted to destroy Jesus' ministry, how he continuously tries to confuse biblical issues, and how God works to establish truly spiritual people.

In his conversational tone, Tarry begins the walk through the New Testament with a look at Jesus' life on earth. He contrasts Jesus' purposes with Satan's schemes and gives examples of Satan's attempts to thwart God's divine plans, including through the use of temptations of physical needs and distractions through family members and close friends. Tarry continues with an in-depth review of Jesus' death and resurrection and what those events meant for Satan. *Jesus Restores True Spirituality* concludes with a study of the church's beginnings and examines both the true and false doctrines that the New Testament addresses.



Tarry's detailed commentary and abundant use of Scripture make the New Testament easy to understand and apply to everyday life. For further practicality, at the end of each chapter Tarry includes questions that can be used for personal or small-group study.

Joe E. Tarry was born near Lovington, NM, in 1935. He and his wife, Leona, are retired missionaries and live in Ruidoso, NM. His first book, *Did Paul Approve of the Tongues Spoken in Corinth?*, explores 1 and 2 Corinthians and Paul's conclusions about the practice of speaking in tongues. Tarry's second book, *Created to be Spiritual: Understanding God's daily battle with Satan for the hearts and minds of His people*, he explains story after dramatic story in the Old Testament to show how Satan tries to undermine the spiritual growth of believers.
